

2015 A Class World Championship

Equipment Inspection

An Equipment Inspection will take place at the A Class Worlds at the PuntAla Camping Resort in terms of The Equipment Inspection Regulations as posted on the official website.

Please note the following points before arriving at Punta Ala.

1. This is an Equipment Inspection, not a Fundamental Measurement. You must ensure your boat, sail, mast and boom (if applicable) are measured before arriving and you must hold and present a completed measurement certificate.

There will not be the time, manpower or facilities to undertake Fundamental Measurement at the site.

2. Rule 2 Requirements

A measurement band of contrasting colour, at a distance noted in your measurement certificate, must be on your mast to indicate maximum sail area. This is mandatory.

3. Rule 8 Requirements

Hull appendages below the waterline cannot be closer than .75m from boat centerline, this includes all positions from exiting bottom of hull until fully down.

Hull appendages cannot go outside maximum beam of 2.3m in all positions, this includes all positions from exiting bottom of hull until fully down.

All measurements for hull appendages are to be taken in a static position. Should appendage be moveable in case or box, appendage measurement to be taken with appendage held "at worst" position. In the case of dagger board cassettes, please note measurement may be taken without cassette fully engaged in hull.

4. Rule 4 Requirements

If utilizing cassette type rudders, please be aware that rudder assembly cannot be wider than 76 mm within 153 mm of bottom of hull. Should this measurement be exceeded when blade fully retracted you must be able to demonstrate by way of contrasting colour band on rudder blade or stop or stop type arrangement that rudder blade will meet these requirements whilst racing.

Please contact your national measurer if you have any concerns with the above.
